"After graduating from Old Dominion University with a B.S. in Psychology, I began working and taking photography classes at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston, Massachusetts. As an inner-urbanite, I focused primarily on the interesting juxtaposition of the old and the new – cutting edge architecture being erected right next to some of the oldest buildings in the country – and the effect this change had on the people who lived in the center of the city, the theater district, and Chinatown. The cityscapes of Boston, New York City, and London kept this interest alive for over a decade.
